

Pupil Premium Funding at Sherborne St John CE Primary School

The Pupil Premium is an allocation of additional funding provided to schools to support specific groups of children who are vulnerable to possible underachievement. These include pupils who are entitled to free school meals, those looked after by the local authority or adopted from care and children of armed service personnel. The intended effect of this funding is to accelerate progress and raise attainment. In most cases the Pupil Premium is allocated to schools and is clearly identifiable. It is for schools to decide how the Pupil Premium, allocated to schools per qualifying pupil, is spent, since they are best placed to assess what additional provision should be made for the individual pupils within their responsibility.

All schools are required to report on the amount of funding received, how this is being used and the impact of any work done. We have used the pupil premium funding to continue and extend the work we currently do, ensuring the pupil's progress is tracked closely. Due to the small number of children receiving the funding in our school we have not reported individual attainment data to avoid children being identified. How this data is tracked, recorded and reported to the governors.
