

## TRUST

The Bible has another name for TRUST which was practically demonstrated by characters in the Old Testament and by people who met Jesus, this word is faith. It is our faith and TRUST in Jesus that means we can enjoy His salvation; Galatians 2:16 in the Bible says *“It is trusting in Jesus Christ that makes a person right with God.”* This school value enables us to reflect on something bigger than ourselves and gain a sense of spirituality, understanding that to TRUST God, who we cannot see, is to believe in His promises in all circumstances, in the book of the Psalms the writer says – *“happy are those who TRUST God...” (Psalm 2:12)*

Through developing an understanding of TRUST at school we are able to think about what it means to be trustworthy in everyday life and think about trustworthy role models, whilst sensitively identifying the repercussions when TRUST is broken. This understanding has practical implications for life lessons on friendships and relationships as well as a wider world view.

*“Trust the Lord with all your heart. Don’t depend on your own understanding. Remember the Lord in everything you do. And he will give you success.” (Proverbs 3:5&6)*
