

## Autumn targets for Reading and Writing – Year 2



- To ensure that all sentences make sense and have a capital letter and full stop.
- To begin to use questions marks.
- To use adventurous vocabulary including adjectives and adverbs.
- To ensure that all letters in handwriting are correctly formed. That writing is properly orientated with clear ascenders and descenders.



- Read aloud their home/school reading book regularly. (5 times a week).
- To be able to retell the main events in the texts they have read without using prompts.
- To re-read books to build up their fluency and confidence in word reading.

## Autumn targets for Maths - Year 2

### To develop fluency in addition and

To add and subtract 10 mentally from any two digit number.

Understand that the ones do not change when ten is added or subtracted. This helps to develop fluency for mental addition and subtraction

To know all addition and subtraction facts for each number to 20.

Learning these facts enables children to use inverses to check. Children also can use these facts to check for pairs that are easy to add e.g.  $5+8+2$ , it is easier to add the  $8+2$  first than to begin with  $5+8$  then 2.

Remember there is always 1 more addition or subtraction fact more than the number e.g. 4

$$4+0=4 \quad 4-0=4$$

$$3+1=4 \quad 4-1=3$$

$$2+2=4 \quad 4-2=2$$

$$1+3=4 \quad 4-3=1$$

$$0+4=4 \quad 4-4=0$$
