

Spring targets for Reading and Writing – Year 1



- To continue to write a simple sentence that is punctuated with a capital letter, full stop and begin to use exclamation marks.
- To use adjectives (the **red** car) in writing.
- To correctly spell common exception words. These are words which cannot be phonically sounded out. List attached.



- Read aloud their home/school reading book regularly. (5 times a week).
- To read some of their home/school books more than once, so they can develop fluency and an understanding of what they are reading.
- To continue their phonic knowledge to decode unknown words.
- To identify the main events in a story or key facts from an information text.

Spring Maths Targets for Year 1

To develop fluency in numbers, addition and subtraction.

To continue to work on autumn targets plus

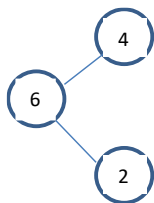
To count in multiples of 2's, 5's and 10's

It is important that children are able to count in 2's, 5's and 10's as this also supports addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Add and subtract 1 digit and 2 digit numbers to 20, including zero.

Children need a range of strategies to be able to problem solve.

Remember an addition number sentence can be inverted to make a subtraction number sentence.



$$\begin{aligned}4 + 2 &= 6 \\2 + 4 &= 6 \\6 - 4 &= 2 \\6 - 2 &= 4\end{aligned}$$
