Dear Parents,

As we near the end of another school year, I would like to take this opportunity to say a HUGE THANKYOU to everyone who has supported the School Association's events this year.

The various events we have organised, including the Christmas Fayre, Quiz night, May Festival, Family Disco, and Summer Fete, have all been well attended, and you have all been extremely generous with your time, money and donations.

During this summer term the May Festival raised £583.34, the Summer Fete raised £1313.44, the SSJ Village Fete BBQ raised £337.00 and sports day raised £183.50 giving us a total of £2,416.78 raised for this term alone!

Some of these funds have already been spent, but we have a healthy balance remaining, ready for the school to decide how they will most benefit the children. The teachers have already discussed how they need new reading scheme books for the whole school.

We are pleased to have funded the following items this year:

- The Big Sing Transport costs
- Year 6 leavers treat
- Coaches for the whole school to attend the "Primary Proms" and the Gilbert White study centre.
