Read age-appropriate books with confidence and fluency

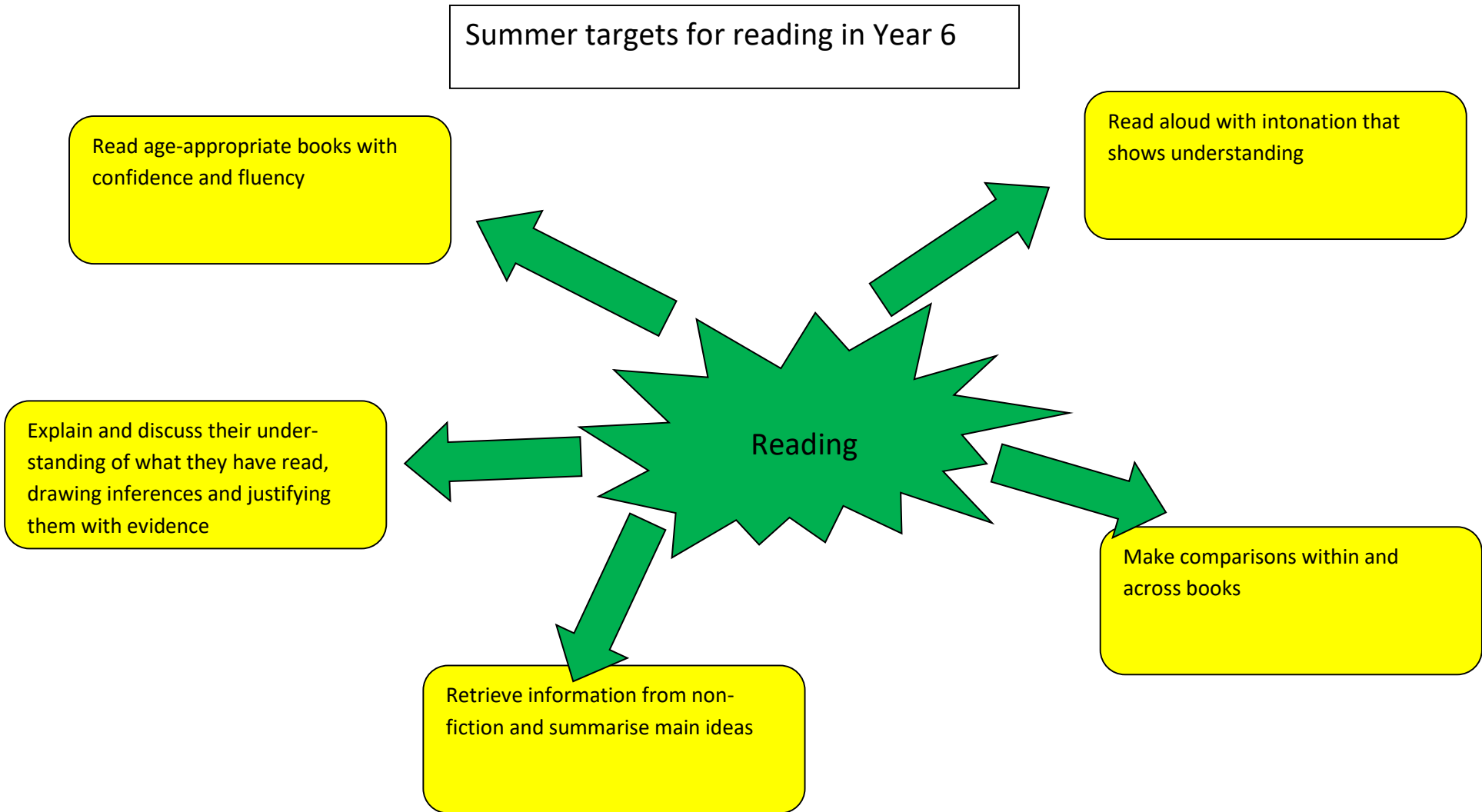
Read aloud with intonation that shows understanding

Explain and discuss their understanding of what they have read, drawing inferences and justifying them with evidence

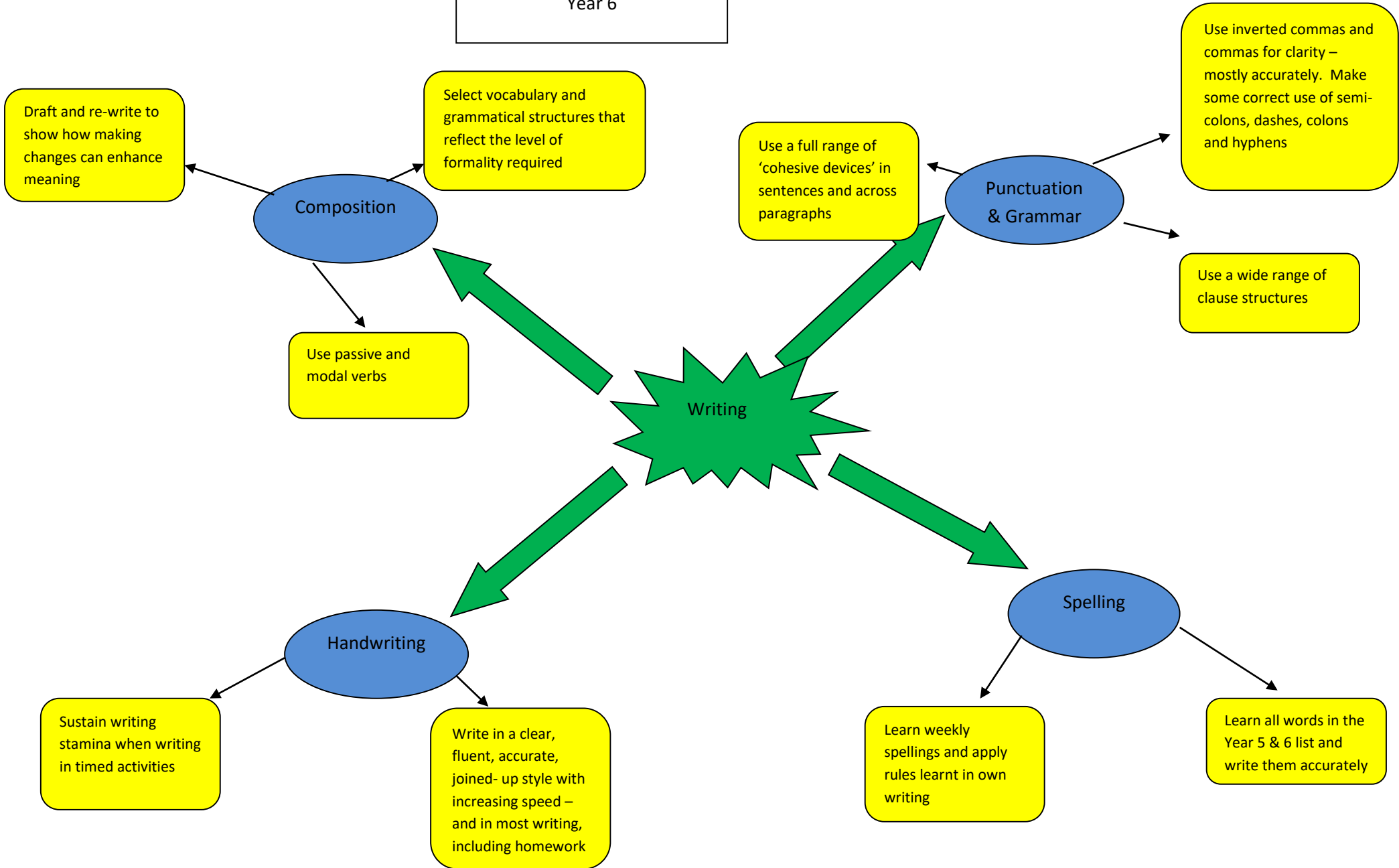
Reading

Summer Targets for Writing in Year 6



Draft and re-write to show how making changes can enhance meaning

Composition

Select vocabulary and grammatical structures that reflect the level of formality required

Use passive and modal verbs

Use a full range of 'cohesive devices' in sentences and across paragraphs

Punctuation & Grammar

Use inverted commas and commas for clarity – mostly accurately. Make some correct use of semi-colons, dashes, colons and hyphens

Use a wide range of clause structures

Sustain writing stamina when writing in timed activities

Handwriting

Write in a clear, fluent, accurate, joined-up style with increasing speed – and in most writing, including homework

Learn weekly spellings and apply rules learnt in own writing

Spelling

Learn all words in the Year 5 & 6 list and write them accurately

Summer Targets Maths in Year 6

Use formal methods to solve multi-step problems

Can use mathematical reasoning to find missing angles

Learn all times tables facts - forwards and backwards

Can recognise the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages

Can use simple known formulae to solve problems (e.g. area of a triangle)

Can calculate mentally using efficient strategies

Can calculate using decimals, fractions or percentages
