- To write correctly punctuated simple and compound sentences. In compound sentences using the conjunctions and, but.
- To punctuate sentences using an exclamation mark.
- To continue to correctly spell common exception words. These are words which cannot be phonically sounded out. A list was sent with the spring targets.




- Read aloud their home/school reading book regularly (5 times a week). Reading some text more than once to support understanding and fluency.
- To continue to use their phonic knowledge to decode unknown words.
- To make simple inferences relating to what is being said or done.
- Discuss the meaning of words, linking them to those they already know.


Summer targets for Maths - Year 1

To develop fluency in numbers, addition and subtraction.


To continue to work on spring targets plus...




To count in multiples of 2's, 5's and 10's



It is important that children are able to count in 2's, 5's and 10's as this also supports addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.



Solve one step problems involving addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions, time, length, weight, capacity and shape.



Children need a range of strategies to be able to problem solve.
