Indicate possession by using the possessive apostrophe with plural nouns

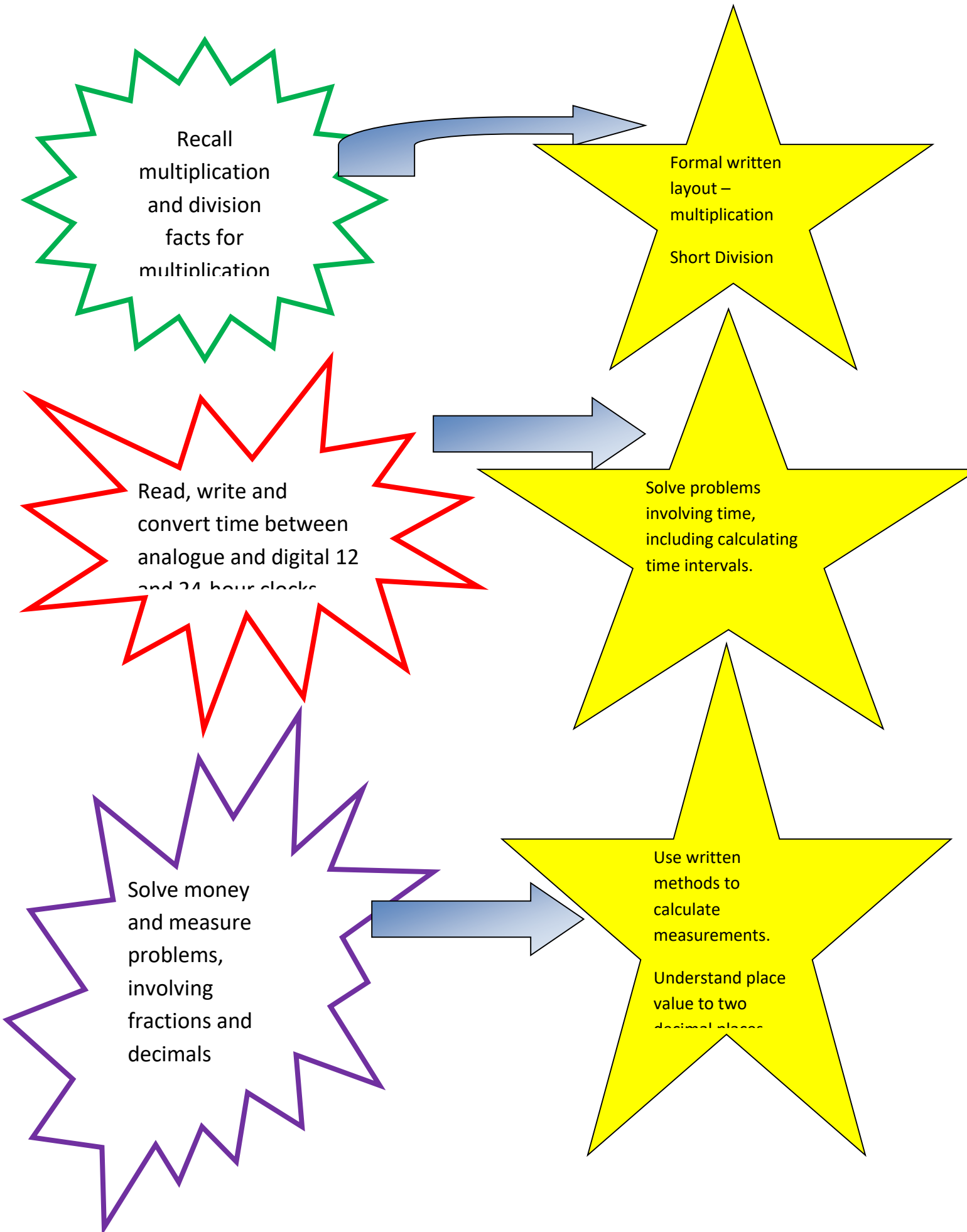


Extract information from the text and make notes using quotation and accurate reference to the text.

Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication

Formal written layout – multiplication

Use written methods to calculate measurements.

Understand place value to two decimal places
